Be an Ambassador to Japan! **Young Foreign-Service Officers and Public Officials** **around the world to participate the program on** **Japanese language, culture and society** **(September 18, 2013 -)**

The Japan Foundation invites young Foreign-Service Officers and Public Officials overseas who are expected to be for posts in Japan and for those who require obtaining the knowledge of Japanese language, culture and society for their diplomatic services related to Japan. The 8 months program is conducted in the Japan Foundation Japanese-Language Institute, Kansai (Osaka Prefecture).

As of 2013, 814 young diplomats have received training. Among them, 217 people have worked for diplomatic missions in Japan and 9 have become an ambassador to Japan.

The 2013 Program will start on September 18, 2013. Total 39 young diplomats and public officials from around the world will come to Japan to participate in the program that covers a wide variety of opportunities to learn Japanese language, culture and society in real-life situations including the lectures in the Japan Foundation Japanese-Language Institute, Kansai, and the visits to government offices, public sectors, non-profit organizations, primary and secondary schools and Japanese families.

Also included in the program promotes to deepen understanding the development of Japanese Science and Technology, the current status of recovery from Great East Japan Earthquake, the interactions with influential figures in the various fields to recognize the goodness of Japan in order for young Foreign-Service Officers and Public Officials to acquire the necessary knowledge and information for diplomatic services related to Japan.
