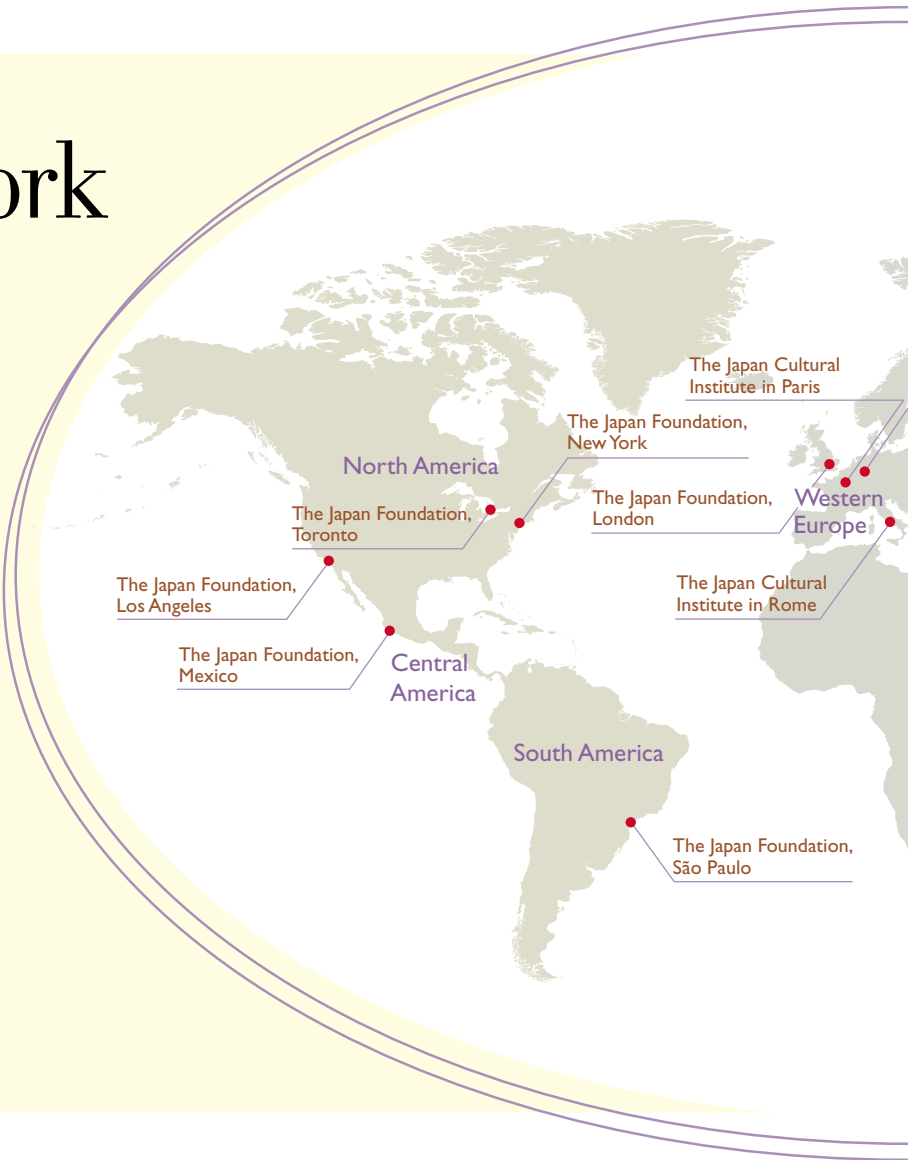


Global Network

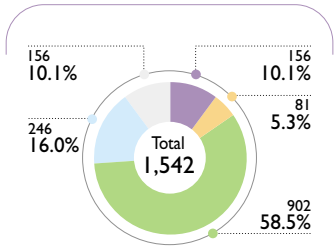


Expenditures by region

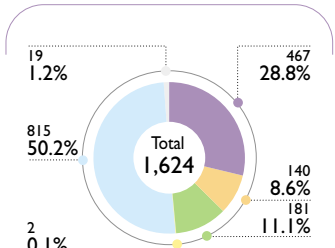

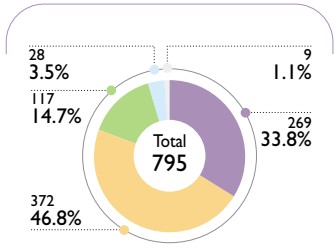

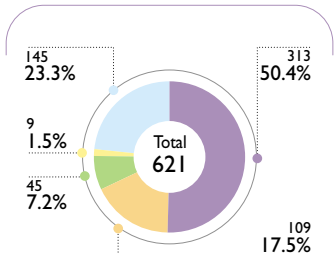

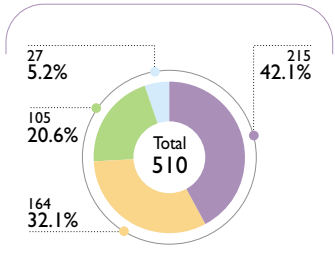

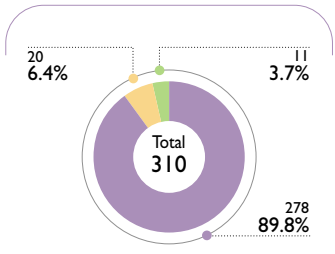

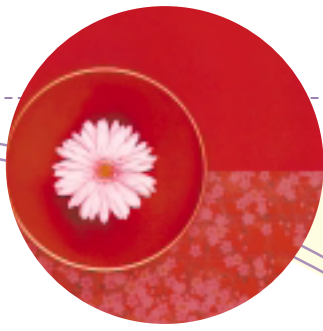

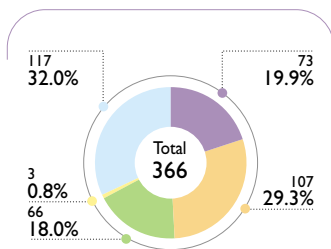

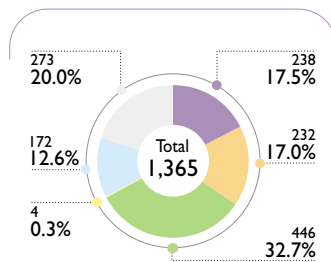

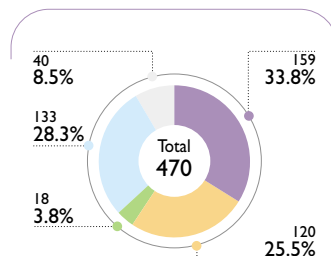
